The BC government's new vision and action plan called "Citizens @ the Center: Government 2.0" will use information technology to transform the way it manages information, connects with citizens and delivers services.

The fly in the ointment? "Citizens @ the Center" will require a massive expansion of the amount of personal information about citizens the provincial government collects, shares internally and discloses to the growing number of public and private sector 'partners' involved with government programs.

BC's current privacy laws are a barrier to realizing these plans, so BC's Chief Information Officer is conducting a confidential consultation and is preparing major amendments to the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act for the Spring.

Speaker Micheal Vonn calls the Government 2.0 plan (which includes massive expenditures on Electronic Health Records and Integrated Case Management) "Total Surveillance for Better Service."
